

Everyone must self-screen before entering the building. Staff must self-screen daily at the beginning of their shift - by entering the building you are attesting that you have self-screened.

REQUIRED PPE

The minimum PPE required to enter any Waypoint building is a surgical mask. Additional PPE may be required in certain circumstances. Masks are located at the main entrances.

1. Do you have any of the following four (4) symptoms not related to known allergies or other chronic conditions?



Fever and/or chills



Cough



Shortness of breath



Decrease or loss of taste or smell

AND/OR

TWO or more of the following new or worsening symptoms?



Runny nose/ nasal congestion

Headache

Extreme fatigue

Sore throat



pain

Muscle aches/joint



Nausea, vomiting and/ or diarrhea

2. In the last 10 DAYS have you tested positive on a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) or PCR test?

3. Do you live with someone who is currently isolating because of a positive COVID-19 test, or has symptoms and is waiting for a COVID-19 test result?

(Answer NO if you've had COVID-19 in the last 90 days / Answer YES if you have not had COVID-19 in the last 90 days.)

- 4. Have you been advised to isolate by public health, a doctor or another health care provider?
- 5. At this time have you travelled outside of Canada AND been advised to quarantine per the federal quarantine requirements?

If you answer **YES** to any of these questions, **DO NOT** enter the building. Return to your car and call the Occupational Health Nurse (OHN) at ext. 2571.

The OHN will determine your work eligibility. If you are excluded from work, you must inform your Manager (or Shift Nurse Manager/Staffing after hours)
