**COVID-19 POSITIVE**

*Staff had high risk exposure to a positive individual and **do not live with the positive case**:*

*Staff had high risk exposure to a positive/presumed positive individual and **live with a positive/symptomatic case**:*

*Staff develops symptoms:*

*Staff is Covid-19 Positive, via either PCR or Rapid Test:*

If staff is **ASYMPTOMATIC**, they may continue to work with the following protocols:

1. Remain asymptomatic
2. NEG Rapid swab every day x 10 days from date of exposure
3. Ensure that PPE use is pristine

- Isolate for 10 days following exposure
- Possibility to RTW on Day 7 with a negative PCR test, or two negative rapid antigen tests on Day 6 & 7

A Symptomatic person in the household is presumed positive until confirmed Negative.

- Isolate for 10 days following onset of symptoms
- Possibility to RTW on Day 7 with a negative PCR test, or two negative rapid antigen tests on Day 6 & 7

- Isolate for 10 days from the positive test result or from onset of symptoms (whichever is earlier)
- Possibility to RTW on Day 7 with a negative PCR test, or two negative rapid antigen tests on Day 6 & 7 or if symptoms have been improving for 24hrs

*(Rapid tests are available for pick-up at Toanche Entrance)*
